The Real Cost of Breakfast

Cafeteria Breakfast vs. Classroom Breakfast: The Choice is Clear

According to findings of the 2009 School District Census Report, a national survey by *Foodservice Director* magazine:

CAFETERIA BREAKFAST:

- The average national cost of cafeteria-served breakfast is \$2.05 per meal
 - The #1 cost component is LABOR, at 51%
 - Even at the maximum "free" federal reimbursement rate of \$1.74, the losses are sizeable
 - o Cafeteria breakfast loses money

CLASSROOM BREAKFAST:

- Increasing breakfast ADP is the key to maximizing your labor costs and reducing your per meal average
 - Classroom breakfast can increase your participation up to 4 times from 20% to 80%
 - Labor costs per meal are driven down while feeding more children, IF YOU INCORPORATE pre-packaged meals
 - Unprofitable cafeteria breakfast becomes profitable classroom breakfast with many more children fed
